

# SafeBlood Graft Procedure <sup>TM</sup>

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## Hx Present Illness/Past Medical Hx/Platelet Graft Therapy:

TH is a 44 y.o. female with profound neuropathy of unknown etiology. She also has complex regional pain syndrome. She develops blisters and ulcers very easily. She heals very slowly despite normal peripheral circulation and excellent nutritional status.

TH does not know how this ulcer developed. She first noticed it 8-29-03. She noticed a "blister" which ruptured and developed into a deep ulcer. It is a very unusual shaped ulcer in an odd location. She has occasional muscle spasms which leads to a plantar flexed attitude of the great toe which compromised healing. It did not make much progress at all until the SafeBlood Graft was performed despite periodic debridements and Panafil.

The SafeBlood Graft was performed on 9-19-03 and the healing was immediate and rapid. She as 90% closed on 10-6-2003 and follow up 11-13-03 showed complete healing and excellent remodelling.
