26 patients presented with various non-healing chronic wounds. The wound types treated included: diabetic foot ulcers, surgical dehiscence and pressure ulcers. The most dramatic outcome with complete epithelialization: a wound with starting volume of 192mm closed in 5 days with one treatment. The slowest to heal: a wound with starting volume of 40,000mm closed in 102 days with two treatments.

19 patients presented with various non-healing chronic wounds. The wound types treated included: diabetic foot ulcers, venous stasis and trauma. The most dramatic outcome with complete epithelialization: a Venous ulcer with a starting volume of 235.6mm closed in 14 days with one treatment. The slowest to heal: a wound with starting volume of 5,089.4mm closed in 74 days with two treatments.
